STCS believes that a good education begins with a positive self image. When students feel good about themselves they perform better academically and behave in a more positive way. The uniform dress code is designed to project a positive self image to enhance our student’s education. We ask for parental cooperation and will insist on student cooperation.

The uniform requirements are outlined below. Please ensure that children are following the requirements for their grade level. School faculty has the right to deem clothing inappropriate.

PLEASE NOTE: the following are not appropriate uniform attire

- **Jeans, cargo pants or low riders**
- **Sport or jeans shorts**
- **T-shirts, form fitting shirts or colored undershirts**
- **Hoodies or Fleece-Tech Vests**
- **Platforms, Flip-Flop shoes or Shoes with heels above two inches**

Students are strongly encouraged to wear sweaters from Oct. 31st until April 1st due to cool temperatures.

Students must be wearing sneakers to participate in gym class. Students in grades 3 – 8 will also be required to bring a change of clothes to wear during gym class.
